This detailing letter supersedes my 24 July 2014 Detailing Memorandum (AE 003F GOV) and limits the authority of the above-named counsel to serve as Special Trial Counsel with regard to all issues arising under or connected with AE 292, to issues that have the FBI investigation (as initially set forth in AE 292) as their factual predicate, or to issues arising under or connected with the Government's request for Defense remediation of material obtained outside of the discovery process through the use of classified systems. These counsel shall not communicate with any person in the Office of the Chief Prosecutor relating to the substance of any investigation or to any matters falling within the defense team attorney-client or attorney work product privileges that they may learn in the course of said litigation.

Newly detailed Special Trial Counsel MAJ Lebowitz ended his service as Assistant Trial Counsel on 24 June 2016, before which he had not been exposed to any matters that could potentially be considered to fall within defense team privileges. Since that date, he has not communicated with any person in the Office of the Chief Prosecutor relating to the substance of any matters falling within the defense team privileges, to the extent any such matters exist, that he may have learned in the course of his duties. MAJ Lebowitz will, among other duties, be the Special Trial Counsel who will notify the Commission of any referral of adverse information to the DIA CAF or DoD CAF in compliance with AE 292QQ, as Amended.
