1. In April 2012, in consequence of a Motion by the Prosecution, the Commission issued an Order¹ authorizing use of closed circuit television (CCTV) to transmit the proceedings in *United States v. Khalid Shaikh Mohammad, et. al.* to specific locations both at the United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, and to the United States. The Order was premised upon the limited seating available in the court room and the difficulty of traveling to the Naval Station.
2. The Prosecution now requests the Commission amend the earlier Order by adding an additional site at the United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, under the same conditions as the previously authorized sites.² The Accused either took no position on the request to amend or did not respond at all.
3. In accordance with Military Commission Rule of Court 3.7.d (3) responses not made within the allocated time are considered waived.

4. The Motion of the Prosecution to amend the previous Order (AE 007B) and transmit the proceeding via CCTV to Bulkeley Hall at the United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, is **GRANTED**.
