**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Defense Motion to Possess and Resume  
Use of a Microsoft-Enabled Laptop  
Computer

19 March 2015

1. In June 2013, the Accused filed a motion requesting return of computers they had used during a previous iteration of *United States v. Khalid Sheikh Mohammad, Walid Muhammad Salih Mubarak Bin'Attash, Ramzi BinalShibh, Ali Abdul Aziz Ali, and Mustafa Ahmed Adam al Hawsawi*.<sup>1</sup> The Commission directed the computers be returned in an Order<sup>2</sup> relating to another motion and at least one motion filed by the Defense since then provides some indicia that the laptops have been returned.

2. The Government will update the Commission as to compliance with the Order not later than 24 March 2015.

So **ORDERED** this 19th day of March, 2015.
