ORDER

**Defense Motion to Compel Prosecution
To Allow Inspection and Photography of
Vehicles Used to Transport Mr. al
Baluchi to/from Detention Facility at
Guantanamo Bay**

3 June 2015

1. Mr. Aziz Ali requested to view, inspect and photograph the transport vans used to transport detainees to/from the detention facilities; the Government originally approved the request with certain conditions, however, after the parties were unable to find agreement on conditions of inspection and photographing, Mr. Aziz Ali filed this motion.¹ The Government's response argues the requests will not produce any relevant or material information and pose "significant force-protection concerns."²

2. ORDER

a. The Defense motion is GRANTED.

b. Defense Counsel may view, inspect and photograph the transport van adhering to the following procedures:

i. Use of proper procedures for information known or believed to be classified;

- ii. Obtain a camera from the Office of Special Security appropriate for the potential security classification of the pictures to be taken;
- iii. Pictures will be taken and diagrams composed after coordinating with JTF as to location;
- iv. Remove the photo disk, treating it appropriate to the security classification for the camera;
- v. Provide the disk and diagrams for classification review;
- vi. Photographs and diagrams will be handled consistent with their classification after review; and
- vii. Return the camera to the Office of Special Security.

c. If any photographs or diagrams are determined not to be classified they will be controlled and disseminated in compliance with Protective Order #2, unless otherwise directed by the Commission or other court of competent jurisdiction.
