**Ruling**

**Government Motion for Extension**  
of Time to Respond to AE305 (RBS)  
and AE305 (WBA)

3 July 2014

1. On 2 July 2014, the Government requested an extension of time to file a response to Defense motion AE305 (RBS) and AE305 (WBA) until two weeks from the date the Defense counsel for bin al Shibh and Bin 'Attash notify the Prosecution that orders for LCDR Hatcher and/or CDR Nhan are no longer to be issued.
  2. Learned Defense Counsel for Mr. 'Bin Attash indicated that they saw no need for a Prosecution response to their motion at this time. Additionally, Learned Defense Counsel for Mr. bin al Shibh indicated that if the orders fell through for some unanticipated reason, he would consent to whatever additional time is needed for the Prosecution to respond.
  3. AE305A (GOV) Government Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to AE305 (RBS) and AE305 (WBA) dated 2 July 2014, is **GRANTED**.
