ORDER

Defense Motion
to Compel Discovery of U.S. – Pakistan
Communications Regarding Pakistani
Citizens Held at Guantanamo Bay

29 JULY 2016

1. On 28 August 2014, Mr. Ali filed a motion requesting the Commission compel production of “all diplomatic letters, emails, and correspondence between the Government of Pakistan and the U.S. Government relating to Pakistani citizens at Guantanamo Bay.”¹ The Government opposed.² The Commission ordered the requested materials to be produced for in camera review.³ After the Government produced the requested materials,⁴ the Commission reviewed them in camera.

2. The Defense motion to compel production of the requested materials is **GRANTED**.
