1. The Defense has filed a motion to jointly withdraw AE 364 (Joint Defense Motion to Compel the Government to Allow Individual Relief During Attorney-Client Meetings).¹ Per Military Commissions Trial Judiciary Rule of Court 3(5)(i) (5 May 2014), a motion is considered moot when withdrawn by the party who originally filed the motion.

2. **ORDER:** AE 364 is moot. To the extent AE 364B (KSM Supp.) seeks additional interim relief prior to resolution of AE 364, it is also moot.
