1. On 3 February 2016, Mr. bin 'Attash filed a motion requesting the Commission abate proceedings until such time as a detailed military defense counsel, with the requisite security clearances, is available to participate in his representation as required by the Military Commissions Act of 2009, 10 U.S.C. §948k.

2. The next session of the Commission is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, 16 February 2016. In order for the Commission to make a determination as to the viability of having this session, an abbreviated briefing schedule is necessary.

3. Any Response by the Government will be filed not later than **1500** on Monday, **8 February 2016**. Any request for an extension to file will be denied.

4. Any reply by Mr. bin 'Attash will be filed not later than **1500** on Wednesday **10 February 2016**. Any request for an extension to file will be denied.
