v.	CANCELLATION ORDER

1. On 14 October 2015, Defense Counsel filed AE 016I, Defense Supplemental Response to Government Request for Entry of Proposed Trial Scheduling Order, where Defense Counsel notified the Commission of a proposed draft modification to their client's pretrial agreement which, if accepted by the Convening Authority, would delay his sentencing hearing for three years. Based upon the proposed modification, Defense Counsel requested the hearing currently set for 17 November 2015 by AE 017, Docketing Order dated 9 October 2015, be vacated. Defense Counsel also requested the Commission vacate the Rules for Military Commissions (R.M.C.) 802 conference currently scheduled for 16 November 2015. Defense Counsel indicated the Prosecution opposed the cancellation of the hearing and the R.C.M. 802 conference, but consented to a continuance of the hearing and R.C.M. 802 conference until after the week of 16 November 2015. (AE 016II at 2-3).

2. Until such time as the proposed modification is acted upon by the Convening Authority, it would be futile to conduct a hearing to establish a trial schedule. Accordingly, the hearing in this case scheduled on 17 November 2015, at the U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, is hereby **CANCELLED**. Additionally, the RMC 802 conference currently scheduled for 16 November 2015 at the U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba is hereby **CANCELLED**. So **ORDERED** this 22nd day of October, 2015.
