SCHEDULING ORDER

7 May 2015

1. On 15 September 2014, the Commission issued AE 015E, setting hearings for the following dates: 17–21 November 2014; 26–30 January 2015; 23–27 March 2015; 25–29 May 2015; and 20–31 July 2015.
2. Upon consultation with the parties pursuant to a Rule for Military Commission 802 conference on 6 May 2015, the 25–29 May 2015 hearing is hereby **CANCELLED**.
3. The previously scheduled dates for the July 2015 session remain in place. It is hereby ORDERED future proceedings in this case will occur as follows:
 - a. 21–25 September 2015;
 - b. 16–20 November 2015;
 - c. 25–29 January 2016;
 - d. 28 March–1 April 2016;
 - e. 23 May–27 May 2016.
4. The prospective setting of trial dates for this commission will dictate the necessity for these and additional future hearings.
5. Delay in the assembly of this commission and trial of this case is excluded in accordance with R.M.C. 707(b)(4)(E)(i) and R.M.C. 707(c) as the resolution of the issues that require the delay outweighs the interests of the public and the accused in a prompt trial.

6. It is hereby ORDERED the hearings will begin at 0900 hours on the first day of each of the sessions. The Accused will be present at the first session of each scheduled hearing date.
