**DOCKETING ORDER

1. A hearing in this case will take place 17-19 November 2014, at the US Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The hearing will begin at 0900 hours on 17 *November 2014.
2. The Accused must be present for the sessions on 17-19 November 2014.
3. The Commission will hear argument on:
 - a. **AE 020**: Defense Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction and to Compel a Status Determination pursuant to Article 5 of the Geneva Convention;
 - b. **AE 021**: Emergency Defense Motion for Appropriate Relief to Cease Physical Contact with Female Guards;
 - c. **AE 019**: Defense Motion to Strike Common Allegations; and
 - d. **AE 018**: Defense Motion to Compel Discovery.
4. An R.M.C. 802 Conference will be conducted at **1700** on Sunday, 16 November 2014, in the Panel Deliberation Room located next to Courtroom 1 in AV 34.
5. If required, a hearing under the provision of M.C.R.E. 505(h) will be conducted at a time to be determined.
6. The time which has transpired since arraignment until the date of the next session (**17 November** 2014) shall be considered excludable delay in accordance with

R.M.C. 707(b)(4)(E)(i) and R.M.C. 707(c) as the resolution of the issues that require the delay outweighs the interests of the public and the accused in a prompt trial.
