The government respectfully provides notice of its intent to change the sites previously utilized at Fort George C. Meade, Maryland (“Fort Meade”) to transmit open commission proceedings via closed-circuit television (“CCTV”) for the media, Office of the Chief Defense Counsel, Office of the Chief Prosecutor, Office of the Convening Authority, Office of the Trial Judiciary, and the general public to more appropriate sites at Fort Meade. Open proceedings are transmitted to two sites at Fort Meade in accordance with AE 028C, AE 028H, and AE 028J. Attendance for viewing Commissions proceedings at the two Fort Meade sites has not fully utilized the available capacity of these sites. The use of the current facilities entails significant site-rental costs for the Office of Military Commissions, and the Fort Meade facilities have endured an increasing demand for training and other events at these two locations. Additionally, one site is scheduled to undergo renovations over the next several months. In recognition of these concerns, and in coordination with officials at the Fort Meade Army Garrison, the Convening Authority has secured McGill Hall, located on Fort Meade, as a single consolidated CCTV viewing facility for the media, general public and victim/family members.
