The Commission ordered the government to provide notice of any discovery produced after 20 September 2013 and to identify the reasons for producing the discovery after that date. AE 45H. On 24 August 2015, the government produced to the defense: (1) Additional information responsive to the defense's supplemental discovery request dated 7 May 2015 ("Discovery Related to Unlawful Influence and Commission Order AE 332U"); and (2) classified discovery recently provided to the government. As to the former, this supplemental discovery is being produced after 10 September 2103 because it pertains to a motion and discovery request filed this year, well after the original 2013 discovery deadline. As to the latter, the classified discovery now being produced is being provided as voluntary discovery and is not triggered by any discovery rule or obligation that would have necessitated its prior production.

The government will—as it has in the past and continues to do—produce all relevant and material information in accordance with the Military Commissions Act of 2009, 10 U.S.C. §§ 948a *et seq.*, Rule for Military Commissions 701, Military Commissions Rule of Evidence 505, and other applicable law.
