The Commission ordered the government to provide notice of any discovery produced after 20 September 2013 and to identify the reasons for producing the discovery after that date. AE 45H. On 22 April 2015, the government produced to the defense: (1) copies of the original signed and/or initialed versions of previously provided Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) FD 302s of Yemeni witness statements; (2) full color versions of photographs that were previously produced within the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) Limburg Investigation Report; (3) a recently declassified FBI FD-192 with chain of custody signature sheet; (4) FBI FD-192 chain of custody signature sheets, most of which were previously produced to the defense, with updated chain of custody signatures.

The government will—as it has in the past and continues to do—produce all relevant and material information in accordance with the Military Commissions Act of 2009, 10 U.S.C. §§ 948a *et seq.*, Rule for Military Commissions 701, Military Commissions Rule of Evidence 505, and other applicable law.
