DOCKETING ORDER
(May 2014 Hearing)

12 May 2014

1. On 18 March 2014, the Commission issued AE 203B and set the dates for future hearings for 22-25 April and 28 April-2 May 2014; 28-30 May and 2-3 June 2014; and, **4-8 August 2014**.

2. It is hereby ORDERED:

a. Proceedings in this case will occur as scheduled in AE 203B, except, upon consideration of the anticipated amount of time required to hear argument on the docketed motions, hearings in May 2014 will occur from 28-30 May 2014. The June 2014 hearings are cancelled.

b. The hearings will begin at 0900 hours on the first day of the session. The Accused will be present on the first day of the May hearing (Wednesday, 28 May 2014), at which time he will be reminded of his right to be present during interlocutory proceedings at his option, in accordance with this Commission's prior written order (AE 099F).

c. The Commission will hear argument on the following motions during the May session, in the following proposed order, subject to refinement at an R.M.C. 802 conference on Tuesday, 27 May 2014 at 1600 at Courtroom#2 (ELC), U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The parties are encouraged to conference in advance and agree on proposed changes to the Commission's planned order of argument:

(1) AE 013N, Defense Motion for Limited Relief from Protective Order #1;

(2) AE 120D, Reconsideration of Decision in AE 120C – Discovery of RDI Program Materials;

(3) AE 206, Defense Motion to Compel the Production of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Report on the Rendition, Detention, Interrogation Program;

(4) AE 266, Motion for Disclosure of Communication by United States Government Agencies and/or Government Officials to the Commission;

(5) AE 267B, Defense Motion to Permit the Accused to Elect Between a Commission Composed of a Military Judge Alone or One Composed of Members as Required by Due Process;

(6) AE 270, Defense Motion for Appropriate Relief: Request for Finding that Government's Notices in AE 045 are Insufficient and Not in Compliance with AE 045H; and,

(7) AE 272, Defense Motion for Appropriate Relief: Inquiry into the Existence of a Conflict of Interest Burdening Counsel's Representation of the Accused Based on Ongoing Executive Branch Investigations.

d. A hearing under the provisions of M.C.R.E. 505(h) will be conducted, as necessary, at the U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The start time will be set during an R.M.C. 802 conference occurring at U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Pursuant to M.C.R.E. 505(h)(1)(C), the hearing will be in camera and closed to the public. The Accused will not be present.
