1. On 10 April 2015, the Commission issued an order abating proceedings in this case pending resolution of two pending interlocutory appeals.¹ In AE 340K², the Government requested the Commission lift the abatement because the pending interlocutory appeals had been decided by the United States Court of Military Commission Review.³ The Defense did not object to the Government motion to lift the abatement.⁴

2. Accordingly, the Government Motion is **GRANTED**. Separate docketing and scheduling orders pertaining to the resumption of proceedings will be published by the Commission.
