1. Upon consideration of the Government's request in AE 345C to place and maintain Attachment B to AE 345A **UNDER SEAL**, and pursuant to the Commission's authority under the Military Commissions Act of 2009, 10 U.S.C. § 948a, *et seq.*, Military Commission Rules of Evidence, Protective Order #2 (AE 14C), and the general supervisory authority of the Commission; and

2. WHEREAS Attachment B to AE 345A contains information pertaining to force protection measures in effect at the detention facility operated by Joint Task Force Guantanamo Bay Cuba, as well as personally identifying information (PII) relating to Department of Defense personnel;

3. IT IS **ORDERED** that Attachment B to AE 345A shall be kept **UNDER SEAL**; and that the Camp Commander's name be redacted at paragraph 11.b. of AE 345A.

4. IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** the name and any other PII of the Camp Commander be considered "sensitive discovery materials" as that term is used in Protective Order #2 (AE 14C); thus his name and any other PII shall not be disclosed to the Accused, any witnesses, any potential witnesses, or made available to the public on the Office of Military Commission public webpage, at any time before, during, or after trial. The name and any other PII of the Camp Commander shall be **SEALED** until further order of this Commission or another court of competent jurisdiction.
