RULING

Defense Motion to Adopt Conforming Amendments to AE 18U (Second Amended)

28 March 2019

1. Mr. Hawsawi moved the Commission¹ to modify paragraph 2(g)(1) of AE 018U, Second Amended Order, Privileged Written Communications Order (PWCO)² to remove the requirement that Controlled Unclassified and Sensitive filings and discovery be identified by the Government as "Releasable to" the Accused. The motion asserts the parties agree these materials are releasable to the Accused, unless the Prosecution specifically marks them as "Not Releasable to" the Accused.³ The motion contained a proposed order changing the last sentence of paragraph 2(g)(1) of the PWCO to read:

2(g)(1). This includes discovery and related material, and records of commission proceedings, including court filings. Court filings may be provided to the Accused including those marked as FOUO, unless they are specifically marked "Not Releasable to the Accused."

- 2. The Government did not oppose the motion or the proposed order.⁵
- 3. **Ruling**. The motion is **GRANTED**. The Commission will issue an amended PWCO in accordance with this Ruling.⁶
