(U) Mr. al Baluchi's Motion to Permanently and Verifiably Disable Audio Monitoring Capability in Attorney-Client Meeting Rooms

(U) April 2019

(U/TOUO) 1. On 17 July 2017, Mr. Ali (a.k.a. al Baluchi) filed a motion to permanently and verifiably disable audio monitoring capability in attorney-client meeting rooms.¹ In AE133AAA, the Commission ordered the Convening Authority to make arrangements for a full technical surveillance countermeasures (TSCM) inspection by a non-SOUTHCOM entity of all JTF-GTMO controlled attorney-client meeting locations at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.² Between 9 October 2018 and 25 October 2018, a non-SOUTHCOM entity conducted a TSCM inspection of all JTF-GTMO controlled attorney-client meeting locations.³ "This inspection in response to AE133AAA, Order did not detect the presence of any operative or inoperative audio monitoring capability of JTF-GTMO controlled attorney-client meeting locations, including those used by Khalid Shaik Mohammad, Walid Muhammad Salih Mubarak bin 'Attash, Ramzi bin al Shibh, Ali Abdul Aziz

Ali, Mustafa Ahmed Adam al Hawsawi, Abd al Rahim Hussayn Muhammad al-Nashiri, and Abd al Hadi al-Iraqi."⁴

(U/TOUC)-2. ORDER. The status quo at the time of the TSCM inspection, to wit, the absence of any operative or inoperative audio monitoring capability of JTF-GTMO controlled attorneyclient meeting locations, shall be maintained. It is hereby ORDERED that no entity of the United States government shall install, maintain, or use any audio monitoring capability in JTF-GTMO controlled attorney-client meeting locations. The prior order of this Commission in AE133QQ Ruling is superseded to the extent it is inconsistent with this Order.
