**Mr. Mohammad's Motion for Leave to
File Out-of-Time Notice of Declination
of Joinder**

8 May 2019

1. **Timeliness.** This motion for leave is timely filed.
2. **Relief Sought.** Pursuant to RC 3.5.i.(2),¹ Mr. Mohammad respectfully requests leave to file out of time a Notice of Declination of Joinder to AE502HHHH (AAA), Mr. al Baluchi's Motion to Reconsider AE502BBBB Ruling, filed 24 April 2019.
3. **Burden of Proof.** The defense bears the burden of persuasion on this Motion for Leave.
4. **Facts.**
 - a. On 24 April 2019, Mr. al Baluchi filed AE 502HHHH.
5. **Law and Argument.** Mr. Mohammad wishes to decline joinder to AE 502HHHH. Rule of Court 3.5.i.(2) requires a motion for leave to file out of time if more than seven calendar days have elapsed since the filing of the initial motion. The seven-day period ended on 1 May 2019.
6. **Request for Oral Argument:** Not requested.
7. **Request for Witnesses:** None.
8. **Conference with Opposing Counsel:** Not required under RC 3.5.i.(3).
