1. On 18 April 2019, Mr. Ali (a.k.a. al Baluchi) filed a motion requesting the Commission reconsider its rulings denying defense motions to recuse. These rulings were made orally on the record on 11 September 2018,¹ and in Appellate Exhibits (AE) 595O² and AE 595EE.³ The Commission finds an expedited briefing cycle is necessary to timely resolve the motion.

2. Order – Expedited Briefing Schedule.

- a. The Government response is due to the Commission **no later than (NLT) 23 April 2019;**
- and
- b. Any Defense replies are due **NLT 24 April 2019.**
