**AE 615:** Defense Motion to Conduct Thorough Inquiry into Actual and/or Potential Attorney Conflict of Interest Pursuant to R.M.C. 901 and Holloway v. Arkansas, 435 U.S. 475 (1978) and to Cancel Proceedings Pending Inquiry.

2. The Commission will hear argument on the issues raised in AE 615 beginning at **1000 on Monday, 28 January 2019** at U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.
