1. Counsel for Mr. bin ‘Atash moved<sup>1</sup> to excuse Detailed Military Defense Counsel, Major Matthew H. Seeger, from the Commission hearings scheduled between 29 April – 3 May 2019. *See* Rule for Military Commissions 805(c). Mr. bin ‘Atash consents to the absences. The Government does not oppose the motion.<sup>2</sup>

2. Counsel for Mr. bin ‘Atash have asserted that other qualified counsel, to include Learned Counsel, will be present to represent Mr. bin ‘Atash. The Defense has not requested a continuance.

3. The motion is **GRANTED**.
