1. Timeliness

This Notice is timely filed.

2. Notice

In AE 624E (AAA), Mr. Ali’s Response to AE 624A (Proposed Order of March), the Defense represented that it had “consulted with the government, who indicated its preference for [the Interpreter’s] testimony on Tuesday, 30 April 2019. AE 624E (AAA) at 2 n.3. However, since that consultation, the Prosecution has learned that the room possessing the secure video-conference platform needed for the Interpreter’s classified testimony is not available until Thursday, 2 May 2019. Therefore, contingent on the decision of the U.S. Court of Military Commission Review, the Prosecution proposes the Commission take the Interpreter’s testimony ordered in AE 350RRR beginning at 0900 on Thursday, 2 May 2019.
