**TRIAL CONDUCT ORDER**

**AMICUS BRIEFS**

1. This Trial Conduct Order (TCO) specifies the application of Rule 8 (Amicus Briefs) of the Military Commissions Rules of Court (RC) (1 September 2016) to all amicus briefs submitted to this Commission.<sup>1</sup>

2. **Order.** Effective immediately, the following procedure applies to all amicus briefs:

a. Amicus briefs may only be filed through a Party to the Commission, and must pertain to an issue or pleading that the sponsoring Party currently has pending before the Commission. The amicus brief must be filed as an attachment or supplement to the sponsoring Party’s pleading.

b. The Commission will not assign an appellate exhibit number to or accept an amicus brief filed outside of these parameters.<sup>2</sup>
