to an issue or pleading that the sponsoring Party currently has pending before the Commission.

The amicus brief must be filed as an attachment or supplement to the sponsoring Party's

pleading.

b. The Commission will not assign an appellate exhibit number to or accept an amicus

brief filed outside of these parameters.²
