1. Counsel for Mr. al Hawsawi moved¹ the Commission to authorize Assistant Detailed Defense Counsel, Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) Jennifer N. Williams, JA, USAR, to appear from the Remote Hearing Room (RHR) in Arlington, Virginia during the 26 September 2022 *ex parte* hearing docketed in AE 895G (Amend).²
2. Mr. Hawsawi does not object to the appearance of LTC Williams from the RHR.
3. The Defense has not requested a continuance.
4. Counsel for Mr. Hawsawi have asserted that other qualified counsel, to include Learned Counsel and Detailed Military Defense Counsel, will be present at Courtroom #2 (CR2), U.S. Naval Station Guantanamo Bay (NSGB), to represent Mr. Hawsawi.
