1. On 18 August 2025, the Commission issued AE 984¹ setting forth the hearing schedule for Calendar Year 2026.
2. This Order amends AE 984 to reflect that the hearings previously scheduled to take place from **5 – 23 January 2026** have been amended to cancel the first week of the scheduled hearings.
3. The remaining amended schedule is as follows:
 - a. **12 - 23 January 2026;**
 - b. 23 – 27 March 2026;
 - c. 4 – 29 May 2026;
 - d. 22 – 26 June 2026;
 - e. 13 – 31 July 2026;
 - f. 17 – 28 August 2026;
 - g. 19 October – 13 November 2026; and
 - e. 7 – 18 December 2026.

4. Not later than **15 days** before the scheduled start of each hearing, the Prosecution shall advise the Commission and the parties of any restriction of movement, medical mitigation measure, material changes to travel procedures, or damage to facilities expected to be used by personnel participating in the hearings.² No advisement is required if there is nothing significant to report.
