1. The following dates are set by the Commission for the Calendar Year 2026 series of hearings at U.S.

Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay (NSGB), Cuba:

- a. 5 - 23 January 2026;
- b. 23 – 27 March 2026;
- c. 4 – 29 May 2026;
- d. 22 – 26 June 2026;
- e. 13 – 31 July 2026;
- f. 17 – 28 August 2026;
- g. 28 September – 2 October 2026;
- h. 19 October – 13 November 2026; and
- i. 7 - 18 December 2026.

2. Not later than **15 days** before the scheduled start of each hearing, the Prosecution shall advise the Commission and the parties of any Restriction of Movement (ROM), medical mitigation measure, or

material change to OMC travel procedure in effect at NSGB.<sup>1</sup> No advisement is required if there are no such policies to report.
