1. In AE 099C, the Commission directed the parties to submit pleadings on whether the 2–4 October 2017 hearing should be continued. In AE 099F the Defense “respectfully request[ed] the military judge continue the [October 2017] session based on Mr. al-Tamir’s current medical condition.” (AE 099F at 1). According to the Certificate of Conference, the Government stated they do not object to continuing the October hearing. (AE 099F at 4).

2. The Defense request in AE 099F to continue the 2–4 October 2017 hearing is **GRANTED**.¹

As ordered in AE 057R, the 2–4 October 2017 hearing is cancelled.
