Supplemental Filings on Outstanding Motions from the January 2019 Commission Hearing

17 January 2019

- 1. A Commission hearing was held on 7–14 January 2019 to hear oral argument on outstanding motions¹ on the published docketing order.² The Commission heard oral argument on issues in Appellate Exhibits (AE) 025, AE 027, AE 028, AE 102K, AE 117, and AE 121.³ Oral argument was not heard on AE 019, AE 024, and AE 085. To the extent the parties desire to file supplemental pleadings in lieu of oral argument, the parties may do so. "Such filings will be narrowly tailored to the issues as they were originally presented and will not raise new issues."
- 2. In a Rule for Military Commission 802 conference held on 14 January 2019, the following deadlines were established:
 - a. The Defense will file any supplemental pleadings NLT 21 January 2019; and
 - b. The Government responses, if any, are due NLT 28 January 2019.
- 3. In light of 21 January 2019 falling on a designated federal holiday, the following modifications to the deadlines are ordered:
 - a. The Defense will file any supplemental pleadings NLT 22 January 2019; and
