Specification: From in or about June 2001 to in or about December 2001, in Afghanistan, and in the context of and associated with an armed conflict, FAEZ MOHAMMED AHMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a ABU KHALLAAD, a/k/a ABU KHALID, a/k/a FAEZ MOHAMMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a KHALLAAD AL KUWAITI, a person subject to trial by military commission as an alien unlawful enemy combatant, with knowledge that al Qaeda has engaged in and engages in terrorism, did provide material support and resources that included, but are not limited to personnel, including himself, expert advice, assistance, and training to al Qaeda, an international terrorist organization engaged in hostilities against the United States, with the knowledge and intent to provide such material support and resources to al Qaeda for that purpose.

ADDITIONAL CHARGE II: VIOLATION OF 10 U.S.C. §950v(b)(28), CONSPIRACY

Specification: From in or about June 2001 to in or about December 2001, in Afghanistan, FAEZ MOHAMMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a ABU KHALLAAD, a/k/a ABU KHALID, a/k/a FAEZ MOHAMMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a KHALLAAD AL KUWAITI, a person subject to trial by military commission as an alien unlawful enemy combatant, did conspire and agree with Usama bin Laden and other persons, including members of al Qaeda, both known and unknown, to commit one or more substantive offenses subject to trial by military commission, to wit: attacking civilians in violation of 10 U.S.C. §950v(b)(2); attacking civilian objects in violation of 10 U.S.C. §950v(b)(3); and terrorism in violation of 10 U.S.C. §950v(b)(24); and that FAEZ MOHAMMED AHMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a ABU KHALLAAD, a/k/a ABU KHALID, a/k/a FAEZ MOHAMMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a KHALLAAD AL KUWAITI knew the unlawful purpose of the agreement and willfully entered into the agreement with the intent to further that unlawful purpose and, in order to accomplish some objective and purpose of the agreement, FAEZ MOHAMMED AHMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a ABU KHALLAAD, a/k/a ABU KHALLAAD, a/k/a ABU KHALID, a/k/a FAEZ MOHAMMED AL KANDARI, a/k/a KHALLAAD AL KUWAITI knowingly committed at least one of the following overt acts:
